

SUBJECT: Township Population Forecast Revisions

At its June 16, 1977 meeting, the Northeastern Illinois Planning Commission voted to accept revisions to the August, 1976 population forecasts for three townships in Will County.

The revised forecasts are:

These revisions do not change the forecasted totals for either the region or Will County.

REVISED TOWNSHIP POPULATION FORECASTS

On August 19, 1976, the Northeastern Illinois Planning Commission formally approved a revised set of township population forecasts. These new forecasts replace those endorsed by the Commission in September, 1974.

The revisions are the direct result of:

- a) new forecasts of region-wide population as suggested by the Illinois Bureau of the Budget;
- b) preliminary township and county forecasts released for review by the Planning Committee in February, 1976;
- c) initial municipal forecasts originally contained in the NIPC staff report to the Illinois Division of Water Resources, dated March 18, 1976;
- d) Kane, Lake and Will county efforts to evaluate and adjust the NIPC staff quarter-section allocation of the September, 1974 township forecasts in consultation with the municipalities in each county;
- e) quarter-section forecasts generated by DuPage County and evaluated by DuPage municipalities;
- f) township revisions suggested by McHenry County;
- g) revisions to municipal results suggested directly to NIPC staff by municipalities in Cook and McHenry counties;
- h) the revised municipal forecasts resulting from items (d), (e), (f) and (g).

The quality of local participation is on the whole, far superior to that generated in 1974. This is due to the focus provided by, first, the offering of municipal rather than township level results for local evaluation, second, the high visibility of the Lake Michigan water allocation issue, and third, county efforts in the context of the '208' Work Program.

These revised forecasts are directly related to the municipal forecasts contained in the updated report to the Illinois Division of Water Resources, dated August 19, 1976.
