


Township Aggregation of Subzones



Polygons outlined in grey represent groupings of CMAP subzones which were used to summarize CMAP forecast data at the township level. They were generated using GIS to assign subzones to township based on the location of each subzone's central point relative to current township boundaries. Additional steps were taken to ensure that subzone assignments for townships which are co-extensive with incorporated places (i.e. Cicero, Zion) matched the municipal subzone assignments for those incorporated places.

Subzones are the primary unit of geography for CMAP forecasting and transportation modeling activities, and are equivalent to Public Land Survey quarter-sections for all of the CMAP region outside of downtown Chicago.

These polygons were created for tabulation purposes only, and are not intended to suggest or predict future boundaries.
